#### Summer 1– Weather

This half term we will be learning all about the Science and Geography of weather. We are going to learn about the different types of weather; we will track the weather in Sheffield using our very own weather station to carry our fieldwork and analyse the results of our data. We will explore how the weather is different around the world and deep dive into a comparison study about weather in the UK vs. the weather in Greece ahead of our Ancient Greece topic in Summer 2.

At the beginning of the half term, we will be writing poetry based on the book 'Tree: seasons come and go' by Patricia Hegarty; later in the half term, the children will be honing their reading skills to explore the book 'Meet the weather' by Caryl Hart before re-telling the story.

In Maths, the Year 1s will be continuing to build on their knowledge of place value, multiplication and division. The Year 2s will be refining their measuring skills and moving to looking at position and direction - did someone say BeeBots?
