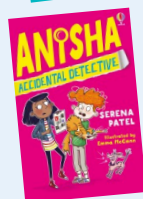


Recommended Reads

New Topic - Tudor England

We are very excited to announce that our topic for the new Spring term is **Tudor England**. In this new topic the children will learn about all things Tudor England. We will concentrate on the history of the period in topic lessons starting with the Battle of Bosworth and moving all the way through the period focussing on the famous Tudor explorers Sir Walter Raleigh and Sir Francis Drake. Not only that, through RE we will be looking at the impact Henry VIII had on religion in the time of the Tudors.



English this term, will be concentrated on one of our brilliant recommended reads: Omar: the Accidental Trouble Magnet. We will be writing an exciting story from a first person perspective and eventually illustrating our writing in the style of the book!
